Mini Masters Academy

An Early Enrichment Program for Children ages 2-4 In Partnership with the Smithsonian Early Enrichment Center

Mini Masters Academy introduces young children to new ideas through a thematic approach to learning that emphasizes relationships and the ability to make meaningful connections. It teaches a basic life skill ... how to learn ... and focuses on strategies and techniques that can be applied to almost any encounter with the unknown.

The focus in not on acquiring facts or information, but rather on the process of learning through inquiry and sensory exploration of objects. It is through this process that children make ideas their own.

The rich resources of the Academy Art Museum offers a wonderful venue for teaching these sensory explorations. The resources come in many forms, from artwork to museum professionals. The focus might be a single piece of art within a collection, an entire exhibition or a visiting artist or musician.

Children's literature, objects and visual images are the key elements of almost every experience. Activities are planned to encourage discussion and increase vocabulary. The curriculum offers a wide range of possibilities and introduces, develops and ties together individual skills in a meaningful way. Skills are also related to the real world and situations that children might encounter.

Children learn to express their feelings and ideas as they talk about objects and works of art they see in the museum. **Mini Masters Academy** embraces a child-centered approach to learning and offers activities that build awareness through sensory experiences.

The schedule is flexible. Children can attend up to 4 days per week with an option to attend a full day program on Tuesdays and Thursdays.

Age Requirements

Children must be 2 years old by September 1, 2018 to participate in the program.

Fees

Payment plans are available. (see registration form) Fees are all inclusive, there are no extra fees throughout the year. The fee includes a Family Membership to the museum.

Arrival for Class

Upon arriving at the classroom, please be certain that one of the teachers is aware that your child has arrived, and provide the teacher with any necessary information at this time. If your child will be picked up by anyone other than you, please notify the teacher at drop off time. (Only those listed on emergency form will be permitted to pick up your child)

Inclement Weather

Mini Masters follows the weather cancellation schedule of Talbot County Public Schools (TCPS), but is open at regular time for any TCPS weather delays. Parents, however, may use their discretion when inclement weather is a factor. Cancellations are announced at 96.7 FM WCEI Radio.

Daily Snack

Parents will have the opportunity to sign up on a rotating basis to provide a snack for the class. Please do not send a drink as water will be available. In keeping with our allergy policy, please do not send nuts or products containing nuts. Please check the ingredients list of all packaged food products before sending them in. There is an area on the emergency form to enter allergy information. Please inform the staff if there is any change to your child's allergy status.

Pick-Up Time at End of Class

Please pick up your child promptly at the end of the session. Parents are required to pick up their children by 12 PM for morning classes, 2:00 PM for afternoon classes. In emergency situations, please call or text to 410-591-0502 to let us know that you will be late. Parents must list on the registration form the names of all persons who are permitted to pick up their child. We require parents to notify Mini Masters staff in writing if someone else will be picking up the child. In a rare emergency situation, arrangements can be made verbally.

Newsletters & Communication

A monthly newsletter is emailed to all families providing news about Mini Masters including curriculum, events and announcements. Communication is a vital ingredient in the success of the Mini Masters experience. For this reason, the teachers are available to answer your questions, or to discuss your ideas and concerns. This is not always possible at the beginning or the end of class, however, an appointment can be scheduled for a time that is convenient for both parents and teacher(s). We will communicate regularly via email, and we hope parents will feel free to email us anytime for any reason at: minimasters@academyartmuseum.org. We also ask that you "like" the Mini Masters Facebook page to see pictures of classroom happenings and activities!

Clothing

Children will be using some materials that may stain clothing. Please keep this in mind when dressing your child each day for class. We ask that parents provide a set of extra, season-appropriate clothing for your child including underwear and socks for use in case of accidents. Parents will be sent periodic reminders when extra clothes, diapers or pull-ups may be needed.

Throughout the year parents will have an opportunity to visit the classroom and participate in special activities. These opportunities will be announced in the newsletters.
